



The Defense Council in Mayarí reinforces control measures in the granting of permits to persons seeking to travel outside the territory or those wishing to enter it, due to the impact of COVID-19 in Cuba.

According to Geovanis Martín Gutiérrez, municipal mayor, from now on, the certificates issued for departures to other provinces will be restricted and can only be granted in exceptional cases, with due verification of the reasons for the trip and in coordination with the Defense Council of the province or municipality of destination.

Martín Gutiérrez said that the new control measures are a response to the complex situation with the confrontation of COVID-19, a disease that continues to cause a high negative impact in the country.

Likewise, the mayor of Mayarí informed that within the province there are municipalities that will also increase the control on the entry of people and the permits to travel to them will be limited, among them Moa and Holguín.
